

COURSE SUMMARY

Abstract to Architecture

Primarily imbues an understanding of what architecture means, nourish students' creativity and associating architecture with principles of design, anthropometry, design process, history and building structures. Learning methodology comprises of documentation, observation, research through feild trips, along with focus on drawing methods. This semester also teaches effective communication skills both verbal and written.

Architectural Space and Form

This semester integrates the basic design theories in small-scale built structures. Students experience the poetics in creating space and form in designing functional spaces. It deals with the understanding of site and its survey and the history of evolution of Hindu temples in India. It introduces timber, cement, steel and RCC as building materials and representational techniques of one point, two point and free hand perspectives.

Space to Place

Explores the transformation of a singular architectural space into a larger contextual place while architecturally representing the varied tangible and intangible aspects that culminate into the "sense of a place". Students are introduced to latest 2D drafting and 3D modelling tools. Techniques of RCC construction, roofing and flooring alternatives are delved into. Further investigation into Islamic, Colonial and contemporary styles is made and subjects like climatology and theory of architecture are introduced. Electives: Architectural Photography, Vernacular Architecture, Visual Communications.

A House and Housing

Sets a link between theory and practice by beginning with the structural and construction methods of RCC structures, steel and aluminum. Design project bridges the gap between the real world and the imaginative, conceptual world by the introduction of housing projects while understanding how spaces and behavior change with design. Students are introduced to building services, Computer Applications in Architecture and various theories of renaissance. Electives: Environmental Responsive Architecture, Product Design, Heritage Documentation.



Familiarises the students with the impact of technology and regulations in shaping architecture in the public domain. Accentuates details of construction technologies for complex structural systems. Introduces the preparation of architectural working drawings for a design project. Electives: Alternate Building Technology and Materials, Digital Architecture and Architectural

Provides the students with a holistic understanding of integrating history, building construction, services, structural and material sciences. Compiles the necessary knowledge systems for successfully carrying out a large-scale design, keeping in mind the interrelationship between different domains of architecture. Electives: Culture and Built Environment, GIS and Design of


Includes three design tasks of three scales - Interior Design, developing the skills of integrating and detailing building systems with aesthetics; Architectural Design, developing students ability to explore performative/responsive designs; Urban Design, to study and analyse the socio-cultural, economic and environmental layers of urban areas. Electives: Craft in Architecture,


Explores the role of architecture in shaping the actors of the urban environment such as public spaces, physical infrastructure and socio-cultural aspects. Focuses on innovative construction systems such as modular construction, high rise design, green building concepts etc. Encourages research on varied ideas and design experimentations. Electives: Research Methods, Real Estate

The professional training semester aims to familiarize students with the structure and functioning of a workplace. It urges the student to better their skills in recording and analyzing the site, software knowledge, in understanding the processes on site and to also expose themselves to the making of working drawings. The Architectural Thesis semester is designed to be an extension to the Thesis seminar (ISARC83) conducted during the eighth semester. The student is expected to explore new ideas and design solutions in addition to demonstrating the skills developed in their previous semesters.


































