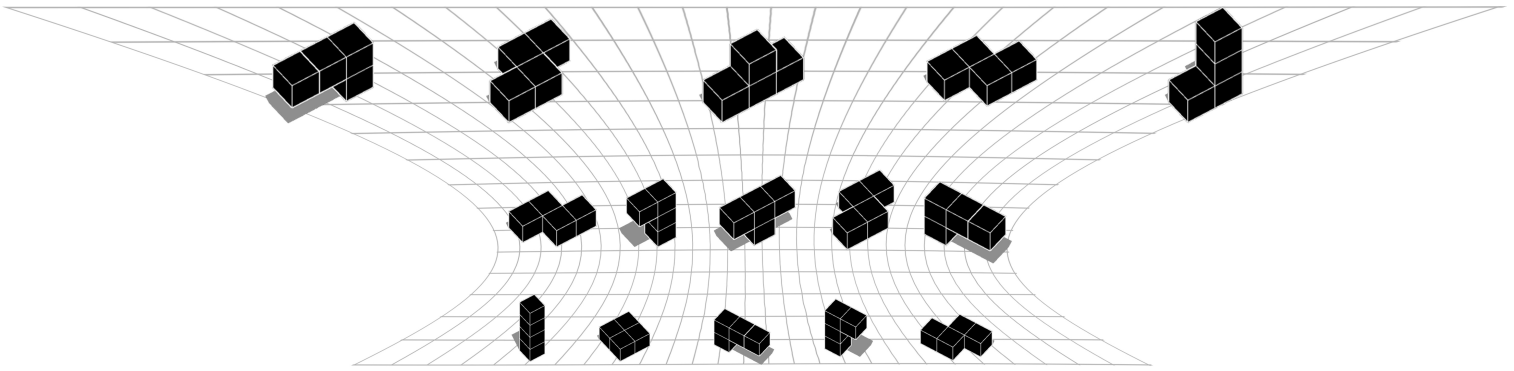

Subcultures such as the ones that impact socio-economic realm at much smaller scales, often invariably inert, empirical or even overpowering, force an inquiry on :

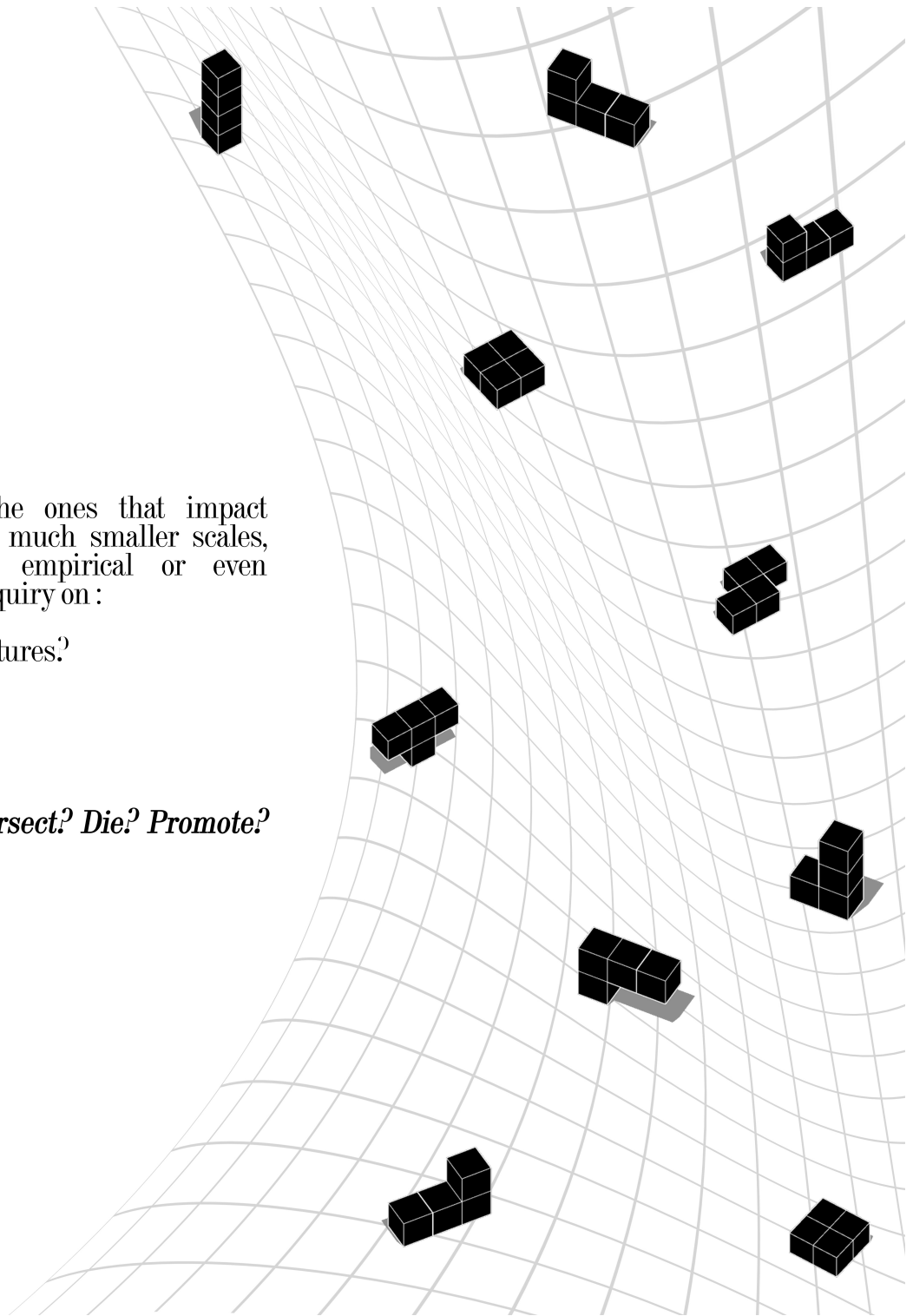

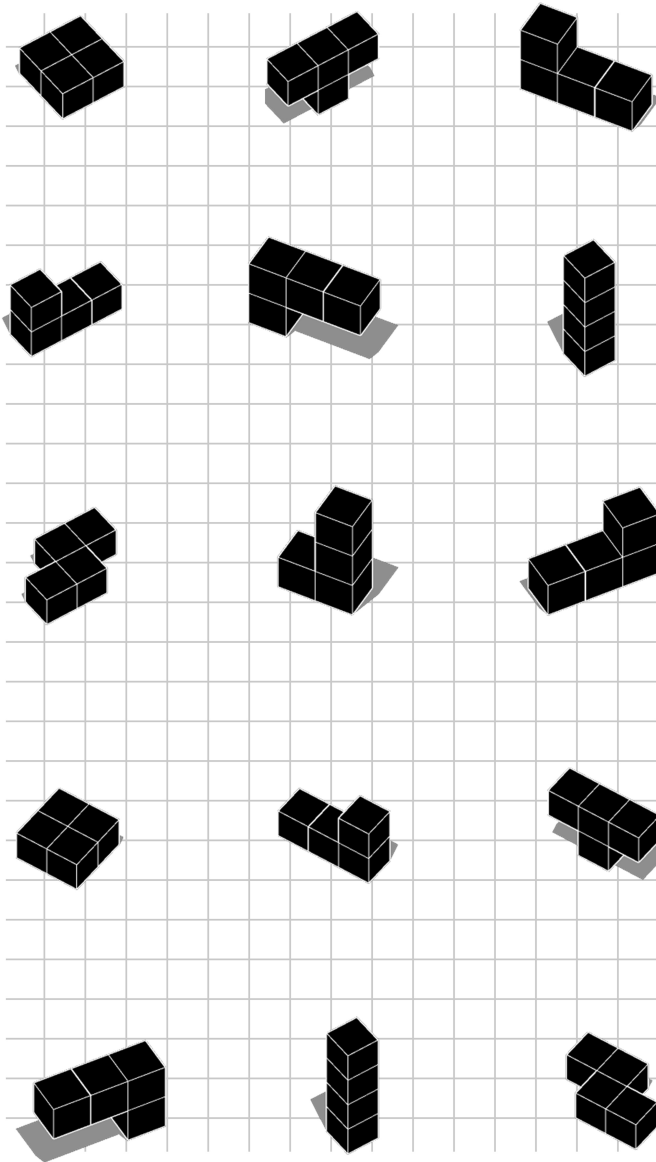
